

Program Staff

Program Staff stay at one area for the entire day and lead 5 program sessions during the day. All programs are planned and all materials are provided.

Program Staff members need to attend one training session. Why?

1. It indicates that you are sincere in wanting to be a "team player" and will make the effort to make this the "best ever" day camp for all Scouts in the Day Camp program.
2. It is mandated by the Boy Scouts of America that every staff member attends "a full day of training". Even if you have previously served on staff, you need to attend a session again this year as each year the program is different.
3. You will receive information regarding your assigned program area as well as general information about the camp and what is expected of you. Again, camp is not the time to attempt to train you how to do projects, run games, etc, and we want you to be comfortable with your assignment prior to camp.
4. Necessary paperwork needs to be signed and T-shirts distributed, and there simply is not time to do so at the camps.
5. Questions can be answered and ideas can be shared in a group setting.
